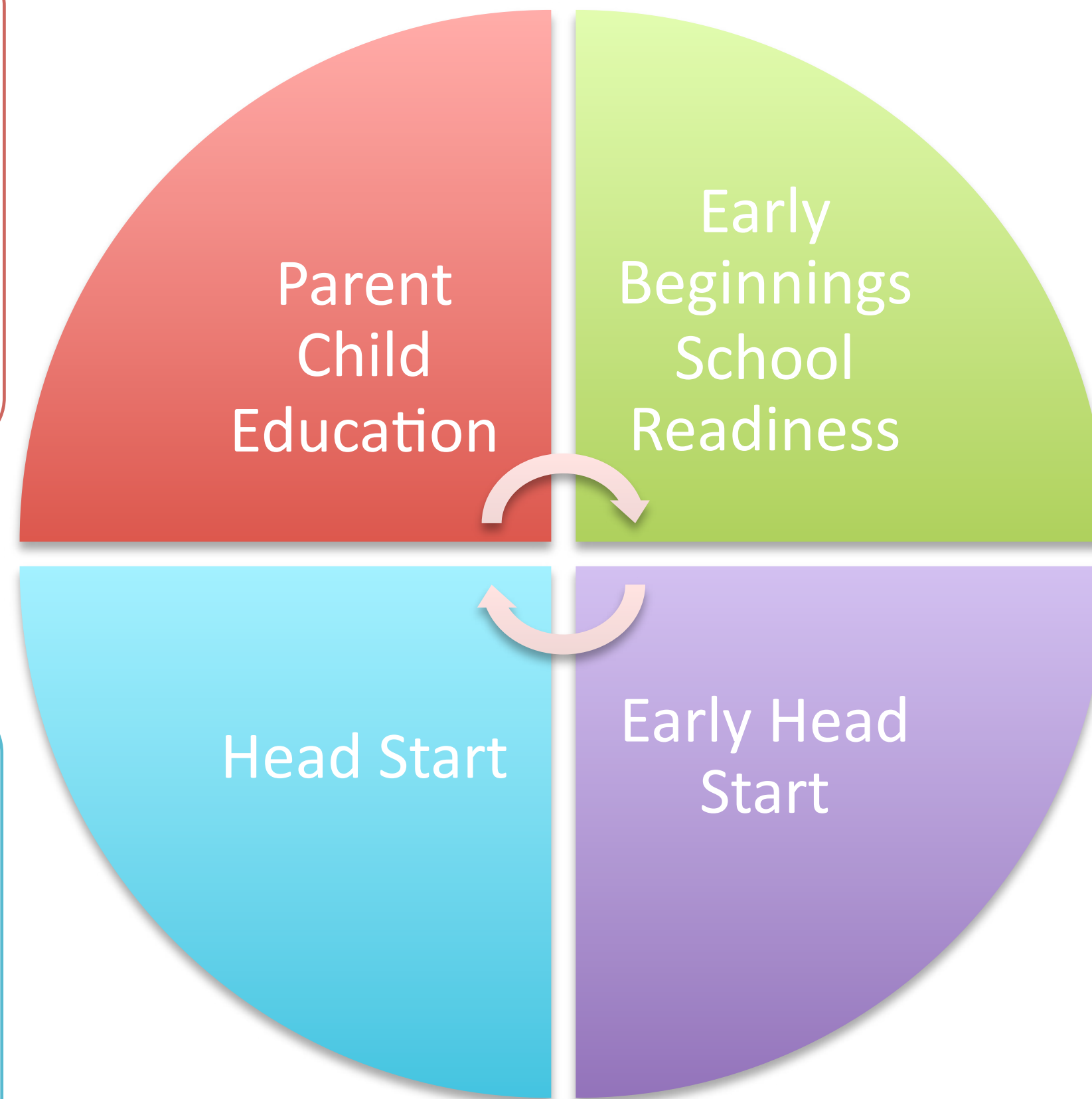


AVANCE Program Services

Two generational approach to teaching both parent and child the value of education. Parents learn how to be their child's first and most important teacher, while children are taught early childhood education.
 Ages: 0-3
 Duration: 9 months

Focus is on non-traditional childcare environments where primary caregiver is a friend, family or neighbor and early childhood education and safety is taught.
 Ages: 0-4
 Duration: 9 week (3x/ school year)

In partnership with Harlandale ISD, this program helps parents prepare their children for school by focusing on education for low-income parents and what they can do during the first years of life in order to be school ready
 Ages: 3-5
 Duration: School year

Focus is on early childhood development for low-income families who primarily reside in the South and West side communities of San Antonio where parental engagement is taught and encouraged.
 Ages: 0-3
 Year around
