General Session 100	The Changing World of Higher Ed - A Conversation About Culture	A discussion on how the culture of higher education is evolving and the impact on people, productivity and results.
Concurrent Session 101	Shift Happens: A Lesson in Paradigms	Join us as we explore how challenging and changing paradigms are necessary for us to identify new ideas and opportunities. Learn how we can embrace changes and prevent self, thoughts, and work procedures from becoming stagnant. Discover the importance of paradigms, paradigm shifts, and the consequences of paradigm paralysis.

Concurrent Session 303	Maximizing Sustainability Through Creative Energy Strategies	In 2015, Hawaii set a 100 percent renewable portfolio standard for the electricity sector by 2045. With that came a mandate requiring all 10 of the University of Hawaii’s campuses to be net-zero by 2035. The University of Hawaii Maui College, which had already been working to improve their campus with the help of energy services company Johnson Controls since 2012, took on that challenge and expedited the timeline with the goal of making their campus net-zero by 2020. Currently, UH-MC is on track to become the first college campus in the United States to reach net-zero. The past three years the campus has harvested \$2.5 million in savings. Participants will hear how this was achieved and what vehicles are available to ensure adequate return on investment.
